Doubting Thomas: The Fear of Being Taken In

One of my great fears is being fooled or being a fool. I am cautious in my decision making, and I am often slow to commit myself to a course of action. I want to make sure that I have as much information as possible before I act. I always try to avoid being found completely mistaken or ridiculously out of touch. My struggle with cancer has been a very difficult one, and it has challenged my desire for certainty and security. I have drawn closer and closer to this grand mystery that stands at the center of our celebrations. Jesus has conquered death, and beyond all hope we are promised a new and eternal life beyond sin, darkness and death. I am certain of that fact. I am slowly losing my strength and health, and inevitably I know that I will succumb to my disease, but that will not be the end of the story. I know and believe that in Christ I will be healed and raised up.



This honest look at my own attitudes brings us to a reflection on today's Gospel. For more than 2,000 years we have called St. Thomas the Apostle, Doubting Thomas, because of his reluctance to accept that Jesus' has risen. We can be harsh in our judgement of St. Thomas, and regretfully shake our heads as he resists the witness of his brothers, and yet I wonder what I would do in his position. Since we have all believed in the resurrection since our childhood, and because we know the story of the resurrection, we can forget that the resurrection was no familiar and comforting fact in Thomas' life. He had abandoned all he knew to follow Jesus. He saw in Jesus the answer to his hopes and dreams. Jesus was the long awaited savior and the liberator of Israel that Thomas longed for. He listened with a burning heart to Jesus preaching, witnessed his power in his miracles and was touched by his love and mercy. He entered rejoicing with him into Jerusalem thinking that Jesus would become the great liberator of his people and mount the throne of David and push the Romans out of his land. And then his glorious vision came crashing down as he saw Jesus betrayed, mocked, tried, crucified, dead and buried. His hopes turned to fear and his visions of liberation into ashes blown away on the wind of cruel hatred and death.

When his fellow disciples proclaimed the resurrection to him he was slow to believe. He had been down this road of faith in Jesus once before, and his experience cried out for caution. It is only in an encounter with the mercy and patience of the risen Lord that Thomas was able to overcome his reluctance and rejoice in this new reality. Thomas' story reminds us that we are witnesses of the resurrection, and that it is only with patient mercy and steadfast joy that we can bring others to trust in the joy of new life. In my world, fearful of being taken in by lies and incomplete information, I must remember each day, the truth that will guide me to trust and faith.

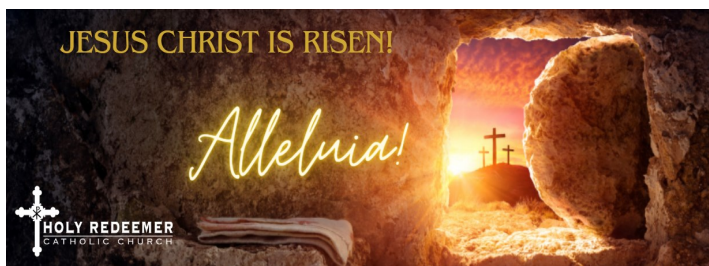

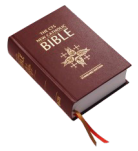

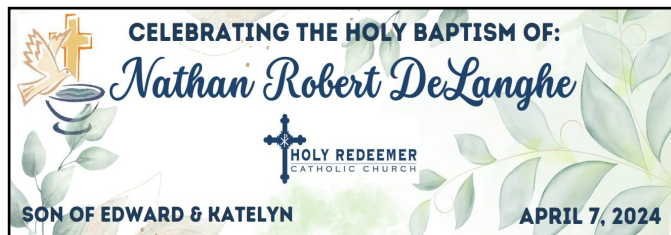
Divine Mercy Sunday This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. The Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday is on the Sunday after Easter and was named by Saint Pope John Paul II at the canonizations of St. Faustina in 2000. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is based on the revelations of Jesus to St. Faustina. Our Lord said to St. Faustina: *“Encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you...Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death...When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior.”* Pamphlets on how to say the chaplet are available in the gathering space and provided by Catholic United Financial.


