


Real Love

The scripture readings this weekend speak about love. It is important that we reflect on the meaning of love and be sure of what we mean when we use the word love. In English our use of the word love can have



several meanings. In Greek there are three words that we translate as love. We find all three words used in scripture. Eros is a physical or sexual love. Phile is a friendship or familial kind of love. Agape is the highest form of love. It is the type of love which is sacrificial, unconditional love for the other.

Agape love is frequently the type of love described in scripture. In our second reading and the gospel, St. John is reminding us of the kind of love we receive from God and the kind of love we are called to show to God and to one another. "God is love." It begins with God and returns to God. In to-

day's gospel Jesus tells us, "This is my commandment: love one another as I have loved you."

Jesus is the perfect example of agape love. He has, in fact, laid down his life for his friends, for his disciples, and for us. Through his death and Resurrection, we have received the grace to love others as Jesus has commanded. He fully gave of himself for all people and invites us into receiving that love and being able to give that kind of love to God and to others. We have a powerful example of agape love in our midst.

Fr. Tony Stubeda, our pastor, has given all of us a powerful example of receiving agape love from Jesus and giving it back to God and to all of us. His struggle with cancer ended on Monday, April 29th when he died peacefully. May he rest in peace with his Lord Jesus Christ.

This weekend we celebrate with our young people at St. Mary's in Cottonwood and at Holy Redeemer in Marshall as they make their First Communion. Last week the second graders in Milroy and Tracy made their First Communion.
